What Makes a Dad

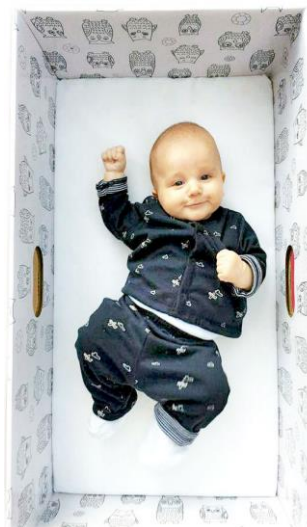
God took the strength of a mountain,

Baby boxes are new baby starter kits that double as a safe sleep space for infants. Each Baby Box comes with a custom mattress with fitted sheet so that it can be used as a bassinet. Based on a program in Finland, Baby Box distribution in conjunction with community health and education supports has helped save countless infant lives over the years. Each Baby Box includes new parent essentials such as diapers, breast pads, brain-boosting activity cards for infants and more. It is as simple as 1, 2, 3.

1. Register on Baby Box University at www.babyboxuniversity.com.
2. Log onto www.babyboxuniversity.com and watch the 10-15 minute relevant syllabus for your region. After taking the quiz, you will receive a certificate of completion which you take a screenshot of or print off.
3. Bring your certificate to Sav-A-Life of Dale County – your distribution center – in order to collect your Baby Box. That's it! Call 774-4419 to check availability – due to arrive in June!

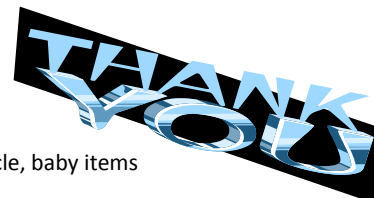
